Built to answer what couples **actually** ask

Every line here is something Northern Colorado couples told us they could not get a straight answer on somewhere else.

Prices you can see

Most Northern Colorado DJs make you call for a number. Ours are right here, all-in.

Ceremony sound included

A separate battery-powered system, a lavalier for your officiant, and a handheld for readings — in the core package, not an upgrade.

The clock starts at the aisle

Six hours from the processional to the last dance, plus 30 minutes of prelude music on us. Setup and teardown are never on your clock.

Announcements included, hype on request

Every cue on your timeline gets announced — entrance, toasts, dances, send-off. Want a full-on host working the room? Add a dedicated MC in the style you choose.

A producer behind the booth

Seeker releases original music. That means a custom edit or mashup for your first dance or grand entrance that no other DJ can make.

You book Seeker, you get Seeker

One wedding per day, no roster, no DJ assigned two weeks out. The person on your planning calls is the person behind the booth.

- ✓ Professional Serato DJ rig with a backup laptop and a second audio path
- ✓ Reception sound: powered tops + subwoofers sized to the room (up to 200 guests; more on request)
- ✓ Ceremony system: battery-powered speaker, wireless lavalier, wireless handheld
- ✓ Wireless handheld for toasts and blessings
- ✓ Cocktail-hour speaker (Ceremony + Reception and up)
- ✓ Dance floor lighting (Ceremony + Reception and up); wireless uplighting (Full Day)

Reception

Up to 5 hours — cocktail hour to last dance

For couples whose ceremony is handled elsewhere, or is unplugged.

- ✓ DJ Seeker behind the booth all night
- ✓ Reception sound system (tops + subs) for up to 200 guests
- ✓ Wireless handheld for toasts and blessings
- ✓ Grand entrance, first dance, parent dances, cake, bouquet, last dance — cued and announced from your run sheet
- ✓ Online wedding planner, planning calls, and a final details meeting

Ceremony + Reception

Up to 6 hours from the processional to the last dance, plus a free 30-minute prelude

The whole day on one system of cues, with one DJ running it.

- ✓ Separate battery-powered ceremony sound — works with no power, wind-aware placement
- ✓ Lavalier for your officiant + handheld for readings; mic or DI for a live musician
- ✓ 30 minutes of prelude music before the processional, free
- ✓ Processional, entrance, unity, and recessional cues rehearsed with your officiant
- ✓ Cocktail-hour sound zone if it's in a different spot

Up to 8 hours, plus a free 30-minute prelude

Long timeline, big room, or you just want every detail handled.

- ✓ A custom edit or mashup for one moment — first dance, grand entrance, or a mashup of your two songs — produced by Seeker

Only what you need

Add any of these to any package. Nothing else gets added to your invoice.

Dedicated MC / host **\$450**

a separate professional host on the mic all night — Low-key, Classic, or Hype

Extra hour, booked ahead **\$150**

Overtime decided on the day **\$200 / hr** agreed before it starts

Ceremony audio (Reception package) **\$350** battery system, lav + handheld, prelude, cues

Cocktail-hour sound zone **\$150**

Dance floor lighting **\$150**

Wireless uplighting (10) **\$300** +\$25 per extra fixture

Custom edit or mashup **\$200** delivered 30 days out for approval

Rehearsal attendance **\$150** Zone 1; Zone 2 adds the travel fee

Ceremony only **\$495** up to 2 hours incl. prelude — for couples with a band at the reception

Generator for a no-power reception site **at cost** the ceremony system is battery-powered, so none is needed there

Not offered: photo booths, cold sparks, dancing-on-clouds, monograms. We'd rather point you to someone who does them well.

TRAVEL

Measured from Old Town Fort Collins

Estes Park counts as home. Beyond that, the fee is flat and printed here.

Zone 1 · 0–45 miles **Included**

Fort Collins, Loveland, Windsor, Greeley, Berthoud, Wellington, Longmont, Estes Park, Cheyenne

Zone 2 · 45–90 miles **\$150 flat**

Boulder, Lafayette, Denver metro, Golden, Littleton, Evergreen

Zone 3 · 90+ miles or over a mountain pass **\$300 + one night's lodging near the venue**

Summit County, Winter Park, Vail, Colorado Springs, Larkspur

- Measured as one-way driving distance in Google Maps.
- Lodging is always included for Zone 3 and for any mountain-pass venue from November to April — weather never cancels your DJ.
- Rehearsal trips follow the same zones.

How we learn **your wedding**

The music is the easy part. The planning is what makes the day feel like yours — and it's all included.

1

Inquiry

You send the date and venue. You hear back within 24 hours with availability and a straight price.

2

Vibe call

Twenty minutes on your story, the venue, guest count, the music you love, the music you never want to hear, whether you want a dedicated MC, and who's giving toasts.

3

Lock the date

A simple agreement and a \$500 retainer. Your date is off the market — one wedding per day.

4

Your planner opens

An online wedding planner for must-plays, do-not-plays, ceremony and special-dance songs, name pronunciations, announcements, the timeline, and vendor contacts. Fill it at your pace.

5

60 days out — music check-in

A call to review the planner. Seeker builds your crate and any custom edit, delivered 30 days out for your approval.

6

14 days out — final details

Timeline locked minute by minute. Cue sheet sent to your venue, planner, photographer, and officiant. Venue advanced for load-in, power, sound limits, and curfew.

7

Wedding day

Arrive 90 minutes early (two hours with a ceremony), sound-check every system, coordinate with vendors, run the show. Afterwards: your Afterparty playlist and one request — a review.

DJ VS. MC

Music and announcements included. **Hype on request.**

The DJ is the music — and the cues

The DJ is the music. Reading the room, mixing, clean transitions, dinner volume versus dance-floor volume, filtering requests through your list, and pacing the night so the floor never empties. Every package also includes the announcements your timeline needs — the welcome, the grand entrance, handing the mic to toasts, releasing tables, the dances, cake, and send-off — read from the run sheet we build together.

A dedicated MC is the voice • add-on \$450

A dedicated MC is a second person whose only job is the room: a full-time host who works the crowd, runs games and shout-outs, keeps energy up between moments, and handles the unexpected while the music keeps playing. Seeker partners with professional wedding hosts for this — add one to any package.

Most couples are happy with clean announcements and a DJ who lets the music do the talking. If you want a host who is part of the party, the add-on makes sure the music never waits for the voice and the voice never waits for the music.

PICK YOUR MC'S STYLE

Low-key

Polished announcements, minimal mic time. The night speaks for itself.

Classic

A warm host — introductions, toasts, and the timeline, clear and brief.

Hype

High energy, crowd participation, games — the host is part of the party.

Pick a style for your dedicated MC; it can change by phase — Classic through dinner, Hype once the floor opens.

THE CEREMONY

Vows people can **actually** hear

- ✓ A separate, battery-powered system at the ceremony site — fields, lakesides, and mountain overlooks with no power are fine. Wind-aware speaker placement and windscreens on every mic.
- ✓ A lavalier on your officiant is how your vows get heard. A handheld for readings. A mic or DI for a guitarist or string player if you have one.
- ✓ Thirty minutes of prelude music before the processional, free. Your coverage clock starts at the processional.
- ✓ Cues for the processional (wedding party, parents and grandparents, then your entrance), the unity or signing moment, and the recessional — then straight into cocktail hour on the second zone.
- ✓ The cue sheet goes to your officiant, planner, and photographer. Cues are rehearsed on the final-details call; rehearsal attendance is included in Full Day or available as an add-on.

SAMPLE TIMELINE

Ceremony + Reception, 6 hours

3:30	Prelude (free) — guests arrive
4:00	Ceremony — processional, vows, recessional
4:30	Cocktail hour on the second zone
5:30	Grand entrance → first dance
5:45	Dinner and toasts
6:45	Parent dances
7:00	Open dancing
8:30	Cake · bouquet
9:45	Last dance
10:00	Send-off

Your timeline is built with you and your planner — this is just what six hours can hold.

FAQ

Couples ask

Do you MC?

Every package includes the announcements your timeline needs, read from the run sheet we build together. If you want a full-time host working the room — games, shout-outs, big-energy intros — add a dedicated MC (\$450) and pick the style.

Can guests make requests?

Your call: open requests, requests filtered through your do-not-play list, or none at all. We settle it on the vibe call.

What if something breaks?

A backup laptop, a second audio path, and spare cables come to every wedding. Seeker also keeps a short list of trusted Northern Colorado DJs who would step in with your complete plan in a true emergency.

Do you play explicit music?

Clean edits by default for the ceremony and dinner. The dance floor is your choice.

BOOKING

The fine print, **not fine**

Retainer

\$500 holds your date. Non-refundable, applied to your total.

Balance

Due 14 days before the wedding. Split it into two or three payments at no charge. Card, ACH, Venmo, or Zelle.

Cancellation

Retainer forfeited. Inside 30 days, 50% of the balance; inside 14 days, the full balance.

Rescheduling

One free date move within 12 months, subject to availability.

Overtime

\$200 per hour, agreed with you or your planner before it starts.

Agreement

A written agreement for every wedding. Venue needs: one 20 A circuit within 50 feet of the DJ area (two with uplighting), an 8 × 8 ft level space, shade for outdoor booths.

Can you mix Spanish-language, country, EDM, and throwbacks in one night?

That is the job. Open format means the crate is built around your guest list, not a genre.

How far in advance should we book?

May–October Saturdays book six to twelve months out. One wedding per day, so once your date is retained it is yours.

What do you wear?

A suit, or all black — tell us the dress code.

Do we need to feed you?

A vendor meal is appreciated on six-hour-plus days, never required.

Do you charge more for Saturdays or peak season?

No. The price in this package is the price.
